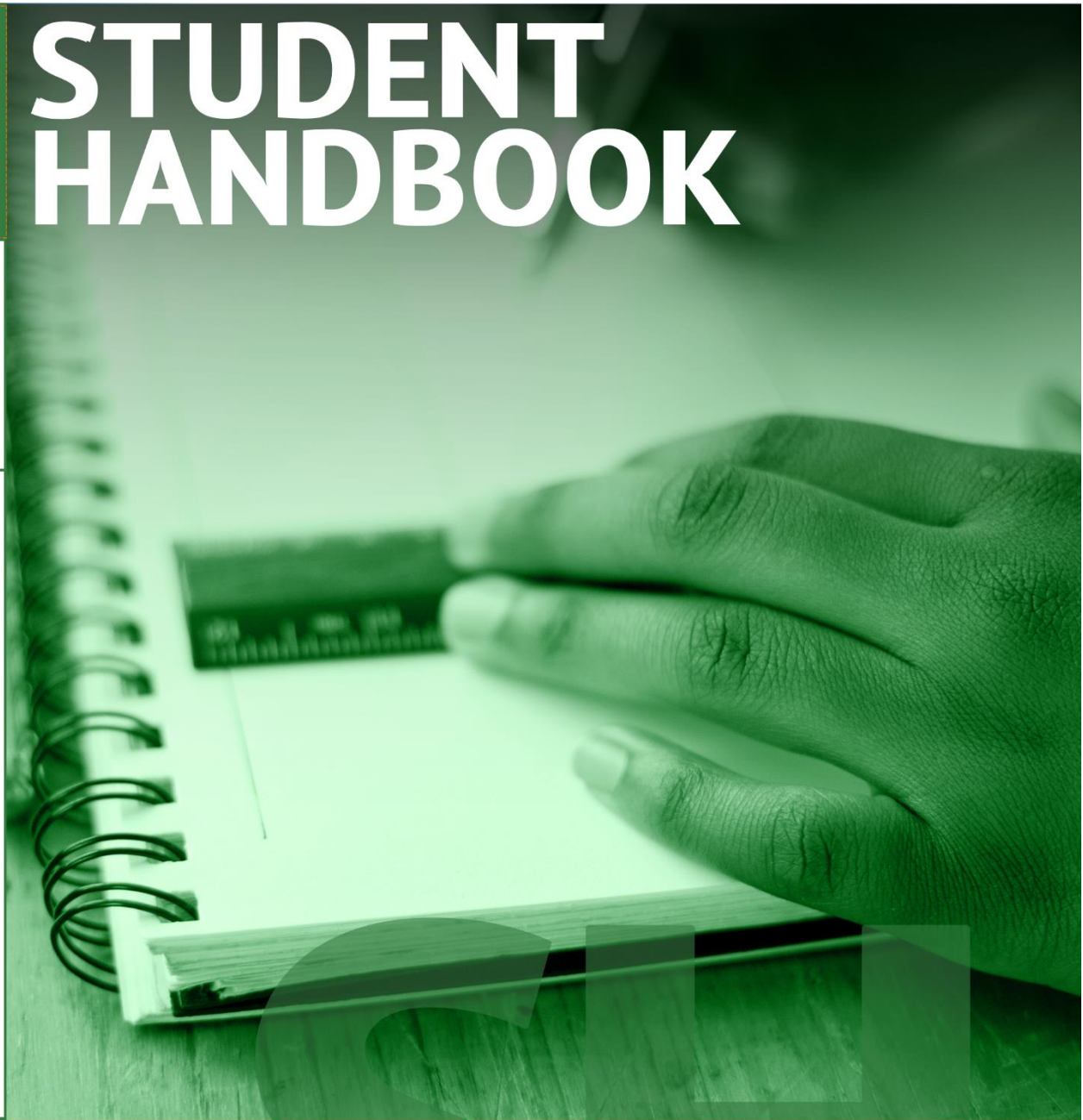

2. ABOUT COGMA

The **Church of God Mission Academy (COGMA)** functions as both an **outreach and teaching arm** of the **Church of God in Caloundra, Australia**. The **Certificate of Biblical Studies**, offered through COGMA, was prepared by the Church of God in Australia.

While COGMA is a ministry extension of the Church of God in Caloundra, it does not aim to **build or plant churches or congregations**. Its **singular focus** is to direct individuals to a **personal relationship with Jesus Christ** and to encourage **deep engagement with His Word**.

Purpose and Inclusivity

COGMA was created to serve as a **home-based ministry education tool** for individuals of all ages, cultures, religious backgrounds, and educational levels.

Self-Paced Learning Model

COGMA's educational model is based on **self-paced learning** through **self-assessment Workbooks**, aligning with international educational standards. This approach encourages students to take personal responsibility for their learning, promoting deep understanding and practical application of biblical knowledge with a focus on mastery.

Biblical Foundation of COGMA's Mission

Central to COGMA's mission is its alignment with the directive found in **2 Timothy 2:2**, which forms the foundation of its educational philosophy.

5. THE STUDY COURSE

Overview

The **Church of God Mission Academy (COGMA)**, based in **Caloundra, Australia**, offers a structured **Certificate program in Biblical Studies**, delivered in two progressive stages:

- The **Silver Certificate**
- The **Gold Certificate**

Each stage builds upon the last, encouraging students to grow in their understanding of Scripture and their relationship with God.

Silver Certificate (Modules 1–12)

The **Silver Certificate** is awarded upon successful completion of **Modules 1 through 12**, including all related assignments. These **foundational modules** focus on:

- **Establishing** solid study principles
- **Guiding** students to a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- **Encouraging** students to seek **revelation and truth** directly from the **Word of God**, through the leading of the Holy Spirit

A key objective of this stage is to **empower students to study the Scriptures independently**, free from **denominational or sectarian interpretations**. This follows the example of the **Bereans** in the Book of Acts, who **diligently examined the Scriptures** for themselves.

At this stage, there is **no formal commitment to discipleship**. The emphasis is on **study and understanding the Word of God**, so that students may learn to **rightly divide the truth** and, in due course, lead others to Jesus Christ.

This mirrors the early journey of **Paul**, who, after encountering Christ, sought a quiet place in the **Arabian desert** to discern the voice of God in His Word and to receive the **revelation of Jesus Christ**.

Gold Certificate (Advanced Modules)

The **Gold Certificate** is awarded upon completion of the **remaining advanced modules and assignments**, which build upon the foundations laid in the Silver level. There is also a requirement to demonstrate ability and willingness to introduce and mentor new students.

These modules explore:

- Deeper aspects of **biblical doctrine**
- Introduction to the **book of Revelation**
- The **biblical mandate to make disciples**

As students advance through this stage, they are encouraged to take on **mentorship responsibilities**, applying what they have learned to **support and guide others in their spiritual growth**.

This reflects COGMA’s commitment to **developing a culture of discipleship**, where **students grow into leaders and teachers**, ready to encourage others in their walk with Christ.

The second stage of the course reflects the **biblical beliefs held by the Church of God in Caloundra**, while remaining **open and accessible** to all sincere students of Scripture.

6. COURSE STRUCTURE AND TOPICS

Overview

The **COGMA Certificate Course** comprises approximately **twenty modules**, supported by a total of **seventy-two workbooks**. These are designed to progressively build a **thorough understanding of the Bible** and the **life of Christian discipleship**.

The modules are divided into two levels:

- **Foundational Modules** (Silver Certificate)
- **Advanced Modules** (Gold Certificate)

This structure guides students from **essential study principles** to **deeper insights** into Scripture and **Christian living**.

Foundational Modules (Silver Certificate)

7. COURSE DELIVERY

Online Access

Commitment and Time Management

As a student, your primary responsibility is to **commit to completing the Certificate of Biblical Studies**. Effective **planning** and **prioritising** are crucial to uphold this commitment.

It is important to recognise that completing your Certificate will demand a **significant portion of your time**, making **planning and goal-setting essential for success**.

Your responsibilities include:

- Completing the **written tasks and reviews** within the Workbooks
- Valuing the opportunity to **fulfil all Workbook requirements**
- Completing both the **Workbook and Module assignments**
- Understanding the **responsibilities involved in being a Biblical Studies student**

Learning Environment and Integrity

The Workbooks are designed for **individual Homebase learning**. While COGMA is not opposed to students engaging in a **classroom-style setting**, all **assignments must be completed individually**, without coaching or copying.

Any suspicion of **cheating or academic dishonesty** will result in **removal from the course**.

Workload

There is **no minimum time requirement** to complete a Workbook and its assignment, as you are encouraged to **study at your own pace**. The exception is the **Module test which is time sensitive**.

If there is **no recorded student activity for six months**, the student will be **deregistered** from the course.

9. STUDENT A LIFELONG LEARNER: THE HEART OF A DISCIPLE

Eagerness to Learn

Eagerness is a crucial attribute for a successful student. It is the **deep desire and hunger to learn** and to discover **truth as revealed by God Himself**.

This sentiment is echoed in **Jesus' Sermon on the Mount**, where He stated:

"Blessed are they, happy are they, fulfilled are they who do hunger and thirst after righteousness."

It is those who earnestly seek the **"right way"** who find true success.

Disciples Are Learners

In the Bible, the followers of Jesus Christ are referred to as **disciples**, a word derived from the Greek term *mathetes*, meaning a **learner or pupil**.

As members of the **body of Christ**, we are **perpetually learners**, continually yearning to know Christ and His ways **more deeply and meaningfully every day**.

Our journey of learning never ceases.

Purpose of the Certificate of Biblical Studies

The **Certificate of Biblical Studies** is designed as a **tool to enhance your discipline** in studying God's Word and to encourage you to **live in accordance with the truths revealed** through it.

Significantly, **Jesus' last words on Earth** to His disciples, His final instruction, were about **making more disciples**.

In **Matthew 28**, Jesus commanded His disciples:

"Go into all the world and teach all nations."

In the original Greek text, the phrase is "to disciple all nations". The Greek word translated as *teach* is *matheteuo*, which means **to make disciples, to become a disciple, or to become a pupil**.

A Call to Discipleship

"As a disciple, a learner myself, I encourage you to become a pupil, a learner. As you progress as a disciple of Jesus Christ, do as I do: use the Certificate of Biblical Studies as a tool and guide to make another disciple. COGMA is here to support you in this journey."

Not Academic, but Life-Focused

The **Certificate of Biblical Studies** is not centred on **academics or indoctrination**, but rather on the **teachings of Jesus**. It focuses on **life and life skills**.

Following this, the student will:

- receive a **student identification number**

If any additional information is required, a **representative from COGMA will contact the student**.

Accessing the Workbooks

All Workbooks and resources can be **freely downloaded** from the **COGMA website**.

In some locations, **printed Workbooks** are available for a **nominal cost**. For further information regarding availability and delivery, students should contact **COGMA administration**.

Language Availability

Currently, all Workbooks are available in **English**. However, COGMA plans to **progressively translate** the materials into other languages.

Students seeking Workbooks in a **specific language** are encouraged to **submit a request** to the administration. For updates on translation progress, students should check the **COGMA website**.

Online Study Option

It is now possible to **download and complete Workbooks and tasks** directly on **smartphones, tablets, laptops, or desktop computers**, without the need to print out a hard copy.

This digital option allows for greater **flexibility and accessibility**, enabling students to engage with the course **from any location** with internet access.

Workbook Structure and Purpose

- Re-check their work to ensure accuracy

Lesson Reviews

The **Lesson Review** helps students consolidate their learning by revisiting content and previously completed activities. During this stage, students should:

- Check their answers using the Answer Book
- Make corrections where necessary
- Re-check all answers to confirm understanding and accuracy

12. GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES: MODULE TESTS

Purpose of Module Tests

At the completion of each module, students are required to complete a **Module test**. These tests are designed to assess the student's **understanding and application** of the content covered across the related Workbooks.

Assessment Format

Each Module assignment includes a combination of:

- **Multiple choice questions**
- **True/false questions**

These questions are **randomly selected** from the material covered in the Workbooks and are presented in **no particular order**. It is expected that students will be able to complete the test without needing to refer to their Workbooks.

How to Access and Complete Module Tests

To complete a module, students must:

- **Contact COGMA** to determine the **specific Module Test version** assigned to them
- Understand that **each module has several versions** of the test
- Be aware that **each version is individually assigned and recorded** to the student by COGMA

i. Important Note on Compliance

Failure to follow the assigned procedure—including completing a test version not assigned to the student—**will result in the Module Test being declined for assessment**.

Steps to Access and Submit the Module Test

- **Open the Module Test Answer Form.**
The assigned test will open in PdfFiller, COGMA's **secure online form platform**.
- **Complete the Test**
Enter your responses **directly into the required fields** of the online form.
- **Submit for Assessment**
Once completed, **submit the form online**. Your test will be **automatically sent to COGMA** for review and assessment.

13. GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES: ASSESSMENTS

Assignment Evaluation and Progression

When a student submits a **Workbook assignment** or **Module test**, **COGMA evaluates the responses** to determine whether the student has demonstrated **mastery of the material**.

- If the assignment or module test is **correct and complete**, the student will be notified and **permitted to proceed** to the next Workbook or next module.
- If the Workbook assignment or Module test is **incomplete** or contains **incorrect answers**, the student will be instructed to **make the necessary corrections** and **resubmit their work** using the appropriate online form using the link provided using the link provided.

Correction Procedures

ii. Workbook Assignment Corrections

If students are required to make corrections, their **Assignment Answer Form** will be returned to them with an attached **Assessment and Correction Form**.

This is an **online process**, and the student will receive a **link**, similar to how they receive their Workbook assignments. Once the corrections have been completed, the **Assignment Answer Form** and **Correction Form** must be resubmitted **together**.

Each correction must include:

- The **Workbook page number**.
- The **sentence from that page** which the student used to make their correction.

If a student believes their answer has been marked incorrectly, they should provide their **reason** in the **comment section** of the Correction Form.

iii. Module Assignment Corrections

If students are required to make corrections, their **Module Answer Form** will be returned to them with an attached **Assessment and Correction Form**.

This is an **online process**, and the student will receive a **link**, similar to how they receive their Module Test assignments. Once the corrections have been completed, the **Module Answer Form** and **Correction Form** must be resubmitted **together**.

For each correction, students are only required to provide:

- The **reason for the correction**
- No Workbook page numbers are required with corrections; **however it is advised to reference the applicable Workbook.**

If a student believes their answer has been marked incorrectly, they should provide their **reason** in the **comment section** of the Correction Form.

COGMA will **not accept any other form of submission**, as the study program is conducted **entirely online**.

Expectation of Mastery

The expectation for every student is to **achieve mastery** in their studies.

Students **must not proceed** to the next Workbook until this level of mastery is reached. This means they must:

- **Wait for assessment results**
- **Make all required corrections**
- Receive formal confirmation from COGMA before continuing

This process ensures **complete understanding** and the **correct application** of biblical principles before advancing through the course.
